

How to become a 3 RIVERS AMBASSADOR

What is a 3 Rivers Ambassador?

A 3 Rivers Ambassador is someone who wants to protect and restore the waterways in our region and understands the significance and importance of these rivers and streams. 3 Rivers Ambassadors become informed protectors of our water by participating in at least one event in each of our three main pillars during a calendar year.

What are the 3 Pillars of a 3 Rivers Ambassador?

3 Rivers Watch	Art & Ecology	Stewardship
Learn how to spot and report water pollution while kayaking, boating, or hiking by the waterways.	Connect with the ecology of our rivers through educational programming and art-based activities.	Improve and restore the access, quality, and health of our region's waterways through cleanups and riparian restoration efforts.

Why should I become a 3 Rivers Ambassador?

3 Rivers Ambassadors are uniquely positioned with the knowledge and resources to advocate for our rivers. This is a great way to connect with others in Southwestern Pennsylvania that also care deeply for our local environment. Once you become a 3 Rivers Ambassador, you get incentives such as a certificate, recognition in our newsletter, a special edition Three Rivers Waterkeeper pin, discounts on our events and merchandise, and special events just for you and your fellow Ambassadors!

How do I start?

- 1. Sign up for an upcoming program that falls under the pillars**, you can find these programs through links on our 3 Rivers Ambassador page or on our events page on our website.
- 2. At your first event request a 3 Rivers Ambassador card**, you will use this card to track which programs you attended. You'll get your first stamp at the event!
- 3. Attend 3 events (one in each pillar) during the calendar year.** We will offer events throughout the year, but if you are concerned about attending all three please feel free to reach out.
- 4. Fill out the 3 Rivers Ambassador Completion form** found on our 3 Rivers Ambassador page. You'll be hearing from us after that to give our congratulations.
